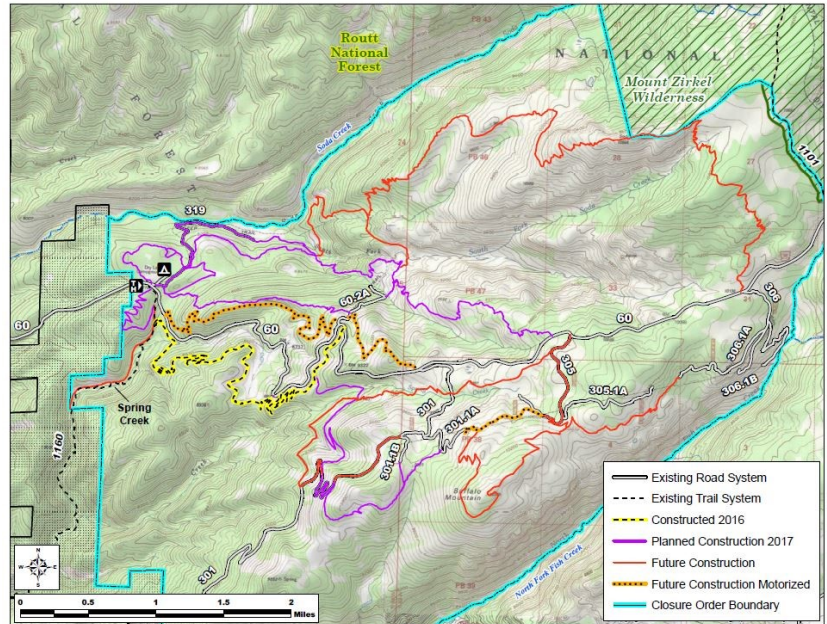


## **New 2A Buffalo Pass Mountain Bike Trail Naming Contest Unveiled**

STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, CO-Ever wonder how particular mountain bike trails received their names. Now you have an opportunity to make history and leave your mark on Routt County by naming the new 2A funded mountain bike trail on Buffalo Pass. Nominations due to the U.S. Forest Service (USFS) by May 1<sup>st</sup>.

Initially dubbed, Buffalo Billy's, this soon-to-be-named trail is an intermediate level multi-directional trail with great views, runs approximately 5 miles long and features both uphill and downhill traffic. Originating near the Dry Lake campground, it allows riders to bypass the Buffalo Pass Road and was completed in the fall of 2016. For details, see the trail marked in yellow on adjacent map.

Submitted entries will be narrowed down by the USFS to a list of finalists, which will be voted on by the public. Public voting will take place between May 15 and June 16, 2017. Individuals can cast their vote either online with a donation to the trail maintenance fund at [yvcf.org/trails](http://yvcf.org/trails) or in person at the USFS office.

The unveiling of the first trail name of the Buffalo Pass trails, constructed in partnership with the City of Steamboat Springs Accommodation Tax, will take place during an anticipated ribbon cutting ceremony currently planned for June 23, 2017.
