STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO-April 12, 2018-The City of Steamboat Springs will host its second Community Workshop on the Yampa River Health Assessment & Streamflow Management Plan on Wednesday, April 18, from 6pm to 7:30PM at the Steamboat Springs Community Center (1605 Lincoln Avenue).

The April Community Workshop will utilize an open format with a short presentation, followed by participant input and discussion. The session will offer interested parties the opportunity to:

- Hear about opportunities for improving river health;
- Learn about proposed 2018/19 project ideas;
- Share thoughts on priority actions and projects;
- Find out more about the steps to plan completion and how to stay involved.

The city and its partners are leading the development of this plan to improve the health and resiliency of the Yampa River through town in the face of shifting climatic conditions and water use demands.

The plan will identify management objectives to support river health and community needs and it will prioritize actions to achieve progress toward healthy river targets. It should be noted, this plan will examine river health and flows holistically and is not intended to focus exclusively on river user conflicts associated with tubing.
