



Microchips do not replace collars and tags, but they make all the difference when it comes to getting your pet back home.

Take advantage of this reminder:

1. Make an appointment with your veterinarian for microchipping if your pet isn't already microchipped; then, make sure that your pet's chip is immediately registered.
2. Check your already-microchipped pet's registration information in the microchip manufacturer's database, and make sure it's up-to-date.
