



## Individual Arrested on Felony Charges After Stabbing Incident

*Confrontation Between Patrons Results In Serious Injury and Arrest*

**STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO-March 17, 2023**-The Steamboat Springs Police Department (SSPD) and the Routt County Sheriff's Office (RCSO) arrested Roymer Aceves Mendoza for felony charges on Monday, March 13, 2023.

The felony arrest stemmed from a stabbing that occurred at the Del Mezcal Tacos and Margaritas Restaurant located at 729 Lincoln Avenue. The incident occurred in the early hours of March 12, after a confrontation between patrons in the bar. The victim sustained serious injuries as a result of the assault.

Investigators arrested Mendoza at Sunlight Drive and Lincoln Avenue on Monday. A search warrant was executed at his residence, recovering additional evidence in the case. Mendoza was arraigned on Tuesday, March 14, 2023.
