



Locals Week Specials Far Better Than Par for the Course

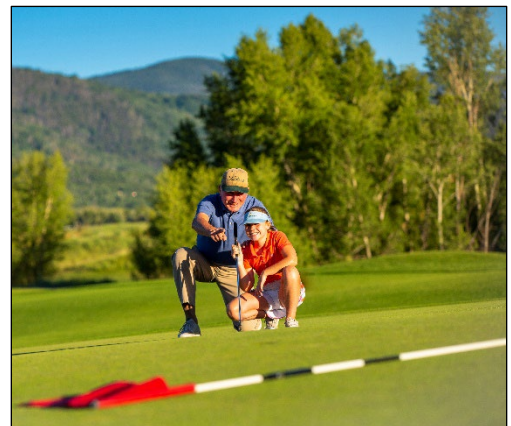
Haymaker Golf Course Event Dedicated to Locals Runs June 1-7
