



ANNUAL SPRING SCORIA CLEANUP

Scoria cleanup is part of the City's Particulate Matter-10 Air Quality maintenance plan. To maintain air quality standards and prevent scoria from finding its way into Steamboat's waterways; during the month of April (weather permitting), the City's Streets Division will be sweeping up scoria that remains on roadways throughout town.

Residents are encouraged to remove scoria from their property and from public rights-of-way within their general vicinity. Scoria can be swept or raked onto the asphalt shoulder of the roadway for pick up via street sweeper. Please keep in mind that long thin lines of scoria are easier and more efficient for the sweeper to pick up instead of large round piles.

Residents are asked to cooperate by not using this service for other spring-cleaning debris. Branches that have been trimmed or trees that have been cut down, as well as other refuse must be disposed of by the resident or a contractor. Any commercial contractors or property management companies who provide this service must remove the materials (including scoria) themselves.
