



April Final Sales Tax Report

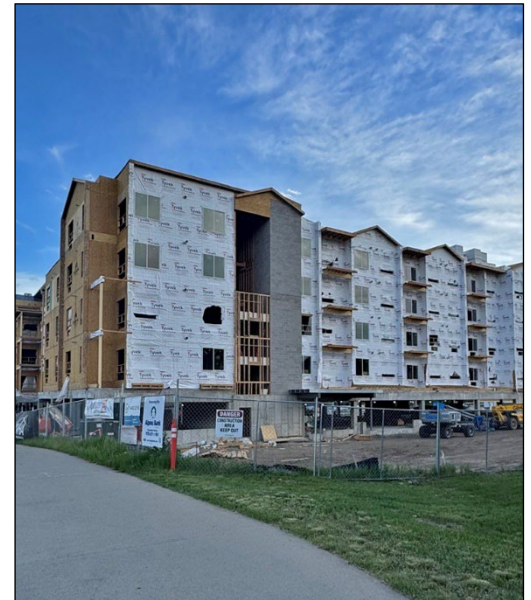
Monthly Totals 6.84% Higher Than Same Time Last Year

STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO-June 16, 2025-The [final April 2025 sales, use, accommodation and STR tax report](#) is 6.84% higher compared to the April 2024 collections or an increase of \$144,311. Year-to-date sales tax collection is 1.37% more than year to date through the same period last year.

When comparing this April to the same month last year the notable changes in collections by category are in construction at 24.16%, grocery stores at 10.75%, and miscellaneous retail at 8.75% over last April. Changes were seen in most geographical area notably West Steamboat and Out of Town areas.

Accommodation Tax is dedicated to maintenance of improvements and amenities that enhance the community identity, environmental sustainability, and economic health of Steamboat Springs; acquisition of real property for parks, recreation, and open space purposes; and preservation of the City's natural resources. April collections are 5.64% lower compared to the same period last year or a decrease of \$3,088.

Short-Term Rental tax (STR tax) is dedicated for use to increase the stock of affordable and attainable housing by providing incentives and contributions to facilitate the development of affordable and attainable housing at locations including, but not limited to, Brown Ranch and to provide funding for infrastructure associated with affordable and attainable housing, including without limitation, energy, stormwater, water, wastewater, and multi-modal transportation. April STR tax collection is 7.23% lower compared to April 2024 or a decrease of \$26,468.



Building Use Tax is used to fund capital projects for the City of Steamboat Springs. This tax fluctuates depending on building permits issued, use tax reconciliations completed, and the size and number of developments in the City. April net use tax collections total \$285,088.
