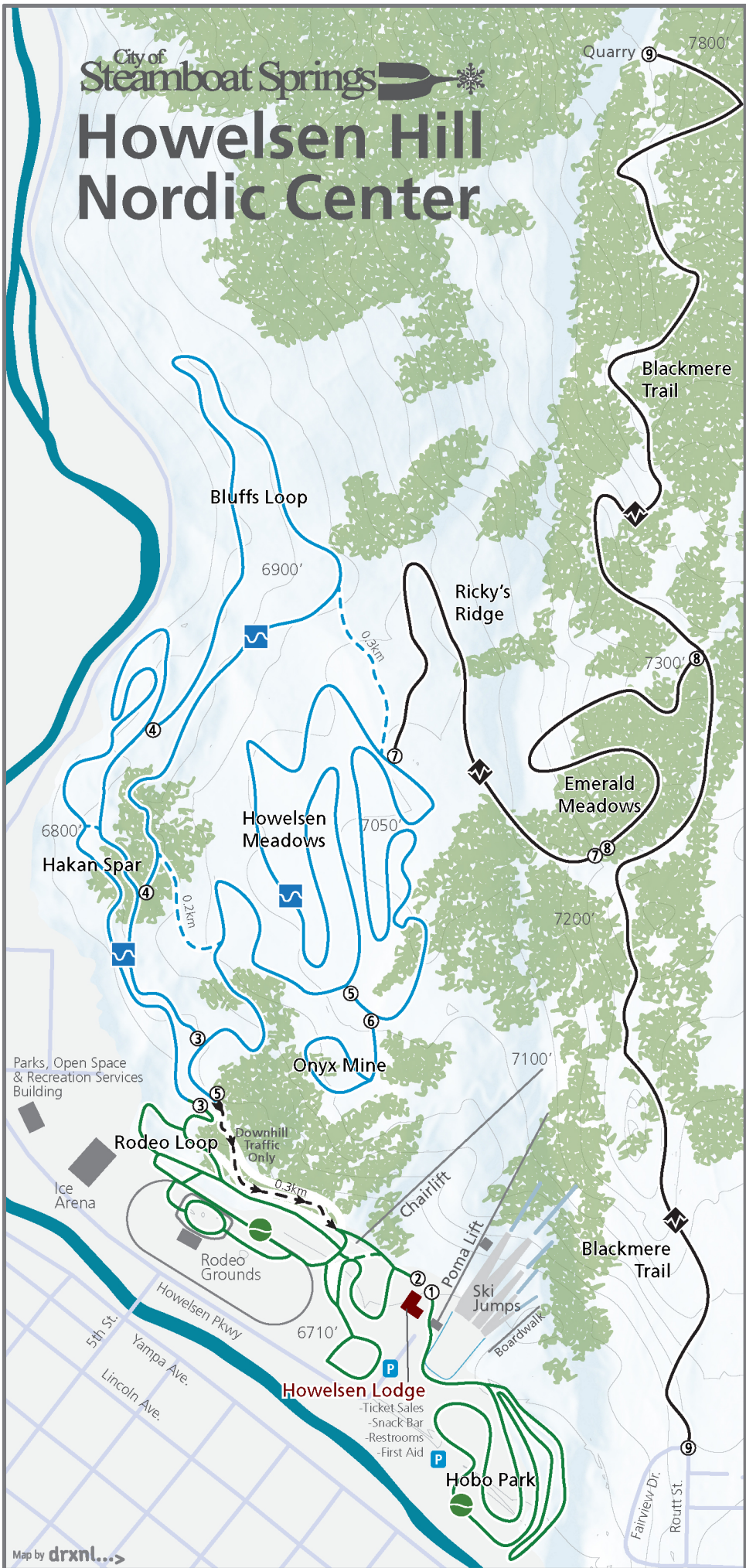

# Howelsen Hill Nordic Center

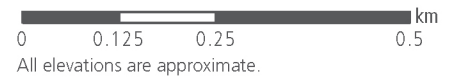


## Welcome to the Howelsen Hill Nordic Center:

- A ticket or pass is required on all groomed trails.
- Blackmere Trail does not require a ticket or pass and is open for non-motorized multiple use by the public.
- Groomed Nordic trails are for the enjoyment of cross country skiers, snowshoers, and fat bikers only; all other uses are prohibited.
- Fat bikes and snow shoers should use the edge of trails and be aware of skiers. Fat Bike etiquette should followed at all times.

① Hobo Park	2.3 km
② Rodeo Loop	3.0 km
③ Hakan Spar	2.1 km
④ Bluffs Loop	2.0 km
⑤ Howelsen Meadows	4.8 km
⑥ Onyx Mine	0.6 km
⑦ Ricky's Ridge	1.0 km
⑧ Emerald Meadows	0.8 km
⑨ Blackmere Trail	3.1 km



### Safety

There are elements of risk in skiing that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce.

1. Maintain control of your speed and direction at all times.
2. Ski in a manner that does not endanger others.
3. Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible by others.
4. Obey all signs and posted warnings.
5. Keep off closed trails.
6. Report all accidents.

Above all, be safety conscious.
