## **9<sup>th</sup> Street Pedestrian Bridge Closing for Reconstruction**

**STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO**-Beginning Monday, April 17<sup>th</sup>, the 9<sup>th</sup> Street pedestrian bridge will be closed for a refurbishment project that includes re-decking and painting of the entire structure. The bridge project is anticipated to last approximately one month, weather permitting.

The 9<sup>th</sup> Street pedestrian bridge is a section of the Yampa River Core Trail that connects downtown to Howelsen Hill. There will be **no access across the bridge** during the duration of the project.



Access to Howelsen Hill and the amenities on Howelsen Parkway from downtown will be via 5<sup>th</sup> Street to Howelsen Parkway. A signed detour will be posted for the duration of the project from the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Howelsen Parkway to the Ambulance/Search & Rescue Barn on Yampa Street.

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
